

## **Creating Child-Friendly Schools and Supporting District Institute of Education and Training (DIET)**

CULP provided Academic support to DIET in Dungarpur district for creating Child-Friendly Schools (CFSs) in the District with the funding support from UNICEF and collaborated with SSA during the period from July 2013 to March 2014. The support resulted to develop the following documents and resources for creating CFSs:

1. Baseline Study Report.
2. Monitoring Indicators of CFSs.
3. Teachers' Guide Book on CFS.
4. Training Manual for both Key Resource Persons (KRPs), Master Trainers (MTs) and Teachers for CFS.
5. Manual for Government Education Officials and academic staff (teacher educators) responsible for supporting schools in the district.
6. Guidebook and training manual for SMCs and PRIs.
7. Trained 30 KRPs to train MTs and 200 MTs to train teachers on CFS.
8. Developed 5 to 10 CFSs in each of five blocks of the district.

### **Proposed Plan**

Now, CULP is planning to up-scale / replicate the project with DIET Banswara for creating CFSs in the district since CULP has been working for ensuring child rights and quality education to the children of deprived tribal communities in five blocks of the district by collaborating with SSA since February 2008. For this, the resources developed with DIET Dungarpur will be used in Banswara because socio-geographical situation of both the district is almost similar.
