

Strengthening School Management Committees (SMC) and PRIs for Effective Compliance of Right to Education (RtE) Act 2009 in Tonk and Banswara districts.

Target beneficiaries: 5000 community members of SMCs & PRIs in all project villages.

Project is collaborated with SSA / State Government and Funding partner

Planned Activities

1. Mobilization of village community leaders and parents and facilitating democratic process for constitution of SMC in school.
2. Induction Trainings of members of SMCs for their capacity building to understand ground reality of school functioning, issues / problems, RtE Act and their roles and responsibilities for effective compliance of RtE norms and implementation of government programmes for school improvement so that quality elementary education could be ensured to all children.
3. Conducting the situation analysis studies of functioning of schools with the participation of SMC members and sharing the data / information and issues / problems identified with them.
4. Facilitating the process for developing School Development Plan with participation of SMC members and teachers based on the findings of Situation Analysis.
5. Mobilizing the members of SMC ensuring their active participation in regular meetings to discuss school related issues / problems.
6. Hand-holding support to SMCs for preparation of proposals and memorandum to submit appropriate government authority for effective compliance of RtE norms.
7. Organizing social audits, people's hearing (Shiksha Samwad) and consultations with key stakeholders.
8. Periodic Review and Planning Meetings with representatives of SMCs, PRIs, Teachers, Government Officials and Project team at block and district level.
